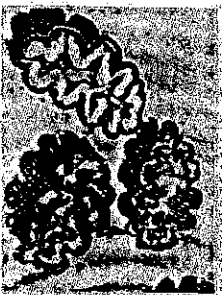


My working journal

1. What are you doing in this picture?
2. How would you improve what you are doing in this picture?
3. What materials OR techniques did you use?
4. Why have you used the technique and materials?
5. Why are they suitable for your product?
6. Did you complete any other research? What research did you complete? **You only answer this question for working journal part 2 **



Example

1. In the picture above I am pinning my dress to the mannequin to see what it would like on a body.
2. I would improve this dress adding more decoration to the bust part of my dress and I could also dye the fabric a blue colour to represent the sea.
3. I used the material Calico to make my dress and I used a technique called gathering to make the decoration of the bottom half of my dress.
4. I used Calico because I like the texture of the fabric as it reminds me of sand. I used gathering because I wanted to make the shape look like the edge of the clams.
5. Calico is easy to work with as it is a very strong and stiff fabric that can hold its shape.
6. I wanted to make sure that the shape of the clams looked exactly like real clams so I researched clams that live under the sea.
