PE Kit

Learners <u>do not</u> need to bring in PE Kit during their Induction Day. Learners will receive their timetable during their Induction. Once the Induction process is complete, all learners in Year 8, 9 and 10 will need to arrive wearing PE kit on the day(s) that they are timetabled to have PE. Learners in Year 7 and 11 will need to bring in their PE kit on their PE day/s, as they will have allocated changing facilities, which are subject to enhanced cleaning procedures.

Phase 2 – Autumn Term

The start/end times, entrance/exits are the same for each year group as detailed in the Induction table above.

Year group and coloured signage will be used across the school to make learners aware of the different zones:

In their bubbles/zones learners will utilise the following classrooms and these will be clearly labelled on their timetable:

- Year 7 GREEN ZONE C009, C010, C011, C111, C108, D103, DS1.
- Year 8 YELLOW ZONE B001, B002, B003, B004, C001, C003A, C003B.
- Year 9 **BLUE ZONE** C101, C102, C103, C104, C105, C106, C107.
- Year 10 **RED ZONE** A102, A103, A104, A201, A202, A203, A204.
- Year II PURPLE ZONE BI01, BI02, BI03, BI04, B201, B202, B203, B204.

Years 10 and 11 will use some specialist option rooms for specific timetabled lessons, a thorough cleaning regime is in place to prevent cross-contamination and learners will be collected from their zone and taken to the options classroom. Learners will follow their normal timetable however, instead of transitioning between rooms, to minimize movement teachers will instead change teaching venues.

On our website there is a PowerPoint slideshow specific to each year group. Form Tutors will go through this information with learners as part of the Induction. This will include a walk to the fire assembly point.
