**Re: Year 9 Options**

I hope you and your family are well.

Firstly, I would like to emphasise how proud I am of all our learners for their adaptability, whilst readjusting to our Distance Learning Programme. We have been extremely pleased with the level of engagement and I would like to thank you for your ongoing support.

As you will be aware, our secondary curriculum model recently changed. As such, I write to provide further details regarding the options process for our Year 9 learners. Please note, details of the changes to our curriculum model were featured in the Trust Autumn Term Newsletter and updated on our academy website under the curriculum tab.

Unfortunately, due to the current climate, we are unable to communicate the options process as we had originally planned. However, the academy is working extremely hard to ensure that Year 9 learners receive the best 'virtual' experience so that they can make informed decisions and 'dream big' for the future.

Learners will choose their option subjects in the latter part of the Spring Term. Therefore, I would like to confirm the following upcoming communications:

- a) Online Assembly (Friday 29/01/21)

An online assembly for Year 9 learners will take place. This assembly will set the scene for learners, detailing what the options process means for them and encouraging them to think about their preferred subjects. An overview of the subjects on offer will be provided as part of the assembly.

- b) A Microsoft Forms Survey (w/c 01/02/21)

Following the virtual assembly, Year 9 learners will be provided with a Microsoft Forms link to an options survey. The purpose of this survey will be for learners to express their initial interest in their preferred subjects. This survey will also enable the academy to forward plan. *Note that this survey will be for learners to register their interest for subjects and not where learners choose their final options; this will be completed in the latter part of the Spring Term.*
