Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, I would like to thank you all for your support during this academic year. As we approach the end of term, I felt it was important to write to you to pinpoint some tips for ensuring that your child stays safe over the summer and for reiterating our return to school plans for the Autumn Term.

On Friday 21st July 2023, we have our end of term rewards assembly. After this, learners will begin to be **dismissed from 12:30 onwards.**

We of course wish all of our learners a very happy and restful Summer. We also want them to stay safe! One of our biggest challenges in school is managing issues that arise from social media. Please do take time to talk to your child about appropriate social media use and appropriate contact and dialogue with others over the multiple platforms that they access. There is obviously a wealth of accessibility which internet access brings for our young people, but this can also pose dangers. We encourage all parents to maintain a healthy caution with regards to social media accounts, ensuring that you regularly check your child's devices and have in place parental controls. Thank you in advance for supporting us with this as it really helps to eliminate social issues and exposure to inappropriate web material.

Please also remind your children of basic road safety and water safety. During hot weather it can be tempting for children to swim in rivers, lakes and reservoirs, but this can pose a very significant danger to them. We want every one of our learners healthy, well and back safely for the Autumn Term. As always, we are here to provide support remotely, our support email address will be checked periodically by the safeguarding team. When learners return in September, it is vital that they arrive in the correct **Academy uniform**. Uniform and PE kit can be purchased from **Crested School Wear**, Churchill Shopping Centre, Dudley, DY2 7BL. Year 11 learners can arrive in their black Link Academy tie, and they will be given their new Y11 tie in the assembly on 5th September 2023. Year 7 learners will receive their first blazer and tie, free of charge. To collect the blazer, you must take ID to Crested School Wear to prove the identity of your child. Ties were given out on the Induction Evening, however, if you have not yet collected your child's tie, this can be collected on their first day in Sept.

Uniform expectations are outlined below, **trainers/boots and canvas shoes or high tops are not allowed**, only black polishable or patent shoes with **no logos/Nike ticks etc.** Learners are also expected to bring a school bag, large enough to fit their books. If your child chooses to wear a **black school skirt, this must be knee length** when walking.

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Learners are expected to bring the following **basic equipment** to school with them:

Failure to bring the correct equipment to school results in a learner losing a line in their planner. Please ensure that your child **does not get facial piercings that can't be removed** in September. Our policy is very clear, only **one single plain stud** is allowed in each ear. Please also ensure that your child does not dye their hair in permanent hair dyes which are not within normal hair colour ranges.
